Set Your Clocks Ahead One Hour... Spring Forward! Daylight Savings Time - March 14, 2021

It's almost that time of year again. Soon the clocks will *spring ahead* for most of the country, and we'll enjoy that extra hour of daylight in the evening. We'll also lose an hour of sleep...

Daylight Saving Time (DST) is the practice of setting the clocks forward one hour from standard time during the summer months, and back again in the fall, in order to make better use of natural daylight. DST in the United States begins each year on the second Sunday in March when clocks are set forward by 1 hour. They are turned back again to standard time on the first Sunday in November as DST ends.

Take time to change batteries in your smoke alarm!



Annual Spring Clean-Up April 9th & 10th Friday and Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Portage Township residents, ONLY.

Township maintenance complex, at 2501 E. State Rd. Dumpsters will be available and township employees will be on hand each day to assist residents.

Metals will be separated for recycling purposes. Residents may dispose of extra items at home, Freon-free appliances, tire rims, oil-free engine parts and small amounts of construction debris. The clean-up is intended to provide an opportunity for residents to dispose of accumulated household items. **It is not intended to be an**

opportunity for residents to cut remodeling and home renovation costs by disposing of siding, shingles, or excessive amounts of other building materials.

NO commercially produced refuse will not be accepted. Household garbage will not be accepted, tires, asbestos, liquid waste, batteries, or yard waste.

As always, proof of residency will be required.

Materials which do not comply with the above guidelines will be refused
