BIANNUAL CLEANUP EVENT

The biannual Portage Township cleanup will be on October 4th & 5th from 9 am – 5 pm at the Portage Township Complex. Dumpsters will be provided for residents to dispose of accumulated trash. Township employees are on hand each day to assist residents in unloading.

Residents may dispose of accumulated trash, such as freon-free appliances, tire rims, oil-free engine parts, and small amounts of construction debris. The clean-up is intended for residents to dispose of household items that are not picked up by residential trash service.

Daily household garbage, tires, asbestos, liquid waste, batteries, or yard waste cannot be accepted. The clean-up is not intended for commercial use or for disposing of excessive amounts of home renovation and construction materials.

LEAF PICKUP



The Portage Township leaf pick-up program helps township residents dispose of leaves without harming the environment. Leaf collection starts in late October and runs through the end of November.

Please help the township workers by keeping sticks and other dense materials out of the leaf piles. Since our equipment has a limited reach, please do your best to keep all leaf piles off the pavement but no further than 6 feet from the edge of the road.

CEMETERY CLEANUP

Cleanup activities will take place the first full week of October. Any decorations remaining during the cleanup will be removed and disposed of by the cemetery personnel. Decorations may be placed on the gravesite again one week after cleanup week is completed.
